➔ **Dragonfly in Race 9 stands out on Kenilworth card.**

Firstly, I would like to take this opportunity to wish the entire racing fraternity all the very best for the new year.

May it be a great year for all, filled with health and happiness.

It was a good week for me after notching up winners throughout the country and I'm glad things have turned for the positive and I'm hoping to continue the success.

Travelling is a normal thing for me after all the years but it's enjoyable when you start travelling for decent rides, which seems to be the case now.

In last week's column both our best bet (Clafoutis 5-2) and our value bet (Second Base 10-1) won, which is always great, and we trust that provided the punters with a great start to the new year.

I was lucky enough to pick up the winning ride on Second Base and to win a Grade 3 is always special, so thanks to everyone concerned.

The focus this weekend is at Kenilworth racecourse and it's the L'Ormarins Queen's Plate Festival, which is always superb to be a part of.

There is no doubt the racing is of the highest quality and the Festival itself sets the standard all year round.

I'm lucky enough to be riding both days at the festival and I'm really hoping to be able to get a few winners on the board.

For the purpose of the column, we will be focusing on today's card which is headlined by the L'Ormarins Queen's Plate over 1600m and backed up by the Grade 1 Cartier Paddock Stakes over 1800m for fillies and mares.

The best horses in the country will be taking their place and it will be a spectacle.

I have six rides on the card.

Race 1 is a Work Riders Maiden Plate over 1200m and I make it a

race in three between my first selection Belle Rouge, who ran a lovely race last time and should follow up, with her main dangers being I'm In Love and What A State.

These three horses should fight out the finish.

Race 2 is a Maiden Juvenile Plate over 1000m, and the suggestion is to watch the betting as your best guide as to the chances of the unraced runners. There are some very well-bred first-timers so it will be important to see the confidence.

Of the two raced runners both Smith And Wesson and We're Jamming finished second on debut and both set the standard but I think the former could be the one to beat.

Race 3 is a Maiden Plate over 1400m and I think Bon Boyage will take all the beating.

His form is the best and he beat the runner I believe to be the main danger in Pomodoro's Jet around three lengths when they met previously, so should confirm the form.

Tchaikovsky and Zum Zum are others to consider for wider bets.

Race 4 is a Pinnacle Stakes over 1000m and I ride Elusive Trader who has a light weight but would have to reproduce his best form to have a chance.

I'm hopeful more than confident.

Real Gone Kid is the horse to beat. He has won two lovely races in his last two starts and seems to be on the up. I think he could be a banker in all bets.

Kasimir is classy and rates the main danger.

Race 5 is the Grade 2 Glorious Goodwood Premier Trophy over 1800m and I ride Nexus, who seems to have had a lovely prep into the race.

This is definitely more his distance and I'm sure he will be cherry ripe on the day so I'm hoping for a decent run.

Do It Again is the horse to beat though. He ran a lovely race in his comeback run and a repeat of that will see him win.

Russian Rock and Sovereign Spirit are others to consider for wider bets.

Race 6 is the Grade 1 Cartier Paddock Stakes over 1800m and what a race it promises to be.

Captain's Ransom sets the standard and I'm pretty confident she will see out the 1800m with her running style.

She has beaten nearly all of the older horses and I'm sure she will confirm the form with them.

Fillies Guineas winner Chansonette, I believe will be the main danger. She gets her weight-for-

age allowance as well as the draw and managed to beat a very-high class filly last time.

I believe these two horses will fight out the finish and get you through all bets.

Race 7 is the Grade 1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate over 1600m and I ride After The Rain who looks like a lovely horse but I'm not sure if he is ready to step up to this class yet.

We are drawn best of all and without it a ticket we don't have a chance so I'm hoping for a decent run.

I think we all have Linebacker to beat. He is a high-class horse whose comeback run was outstanding. I'm sure he would have come on for it and sets the standard.

Rainbow Bridge is superb and is the obvious danger while Jet Dark and Kommetdieding are top-class horses who you will discount at your own peril.

I would include all of the above into bets and I do believe they will be too strong for the three-year-olds in the field.

Race 8 is a MR 96 Handicap over 1400m and I ride Knights Templar, who has been running just off them recently and with a bit of luck in running could get into the placing.

I think T'Challa could be the

one to beat after notching up two lovely wins. He seems to be progressing with each run and could still defy the handicapper.

All About Al and Royal Watch are the main dangers and must be included in all bets.

Race 9 is a MR 80 Handicap over 1400m and I ride Poltergeist, who is an up-and-coming horse who seems to have potential so I believe he will finish in the money but we all have Dragonfly to beat who I make the best bet on the card.

He looks well above average and accounted easily for a decent horse last time and I think he will be very hard to beat.

You Know Who and Que Shiraz are others to consider as dangers and should be right there.

Race 10 is the Grade 3 Okapi Chairman's Cup over 2500m and I ride Salvator Mundi who I make my value bet.

I've watched the replay of his last start and he clearly needed the run, but he could end up being a very high-class stayer and I make him my best ride on the day.

Crimson King and Black Knap are my main dangers.

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

The latter may struggle on these revised terms to confirm the form of a recent meeting with SUPER SILVANO, HOEDSPRUIT and NATIVE TONGUE. Tricky!



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


