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Lerena to foil Snaith charge

READY: KOMMETDIEDING CAN ADD CAPE TOWN MET TO DURBAN JULY TRIUMPH

» **TAB boosted by World Pool betting in eight races.**

The R2-million World Sports Betting Cape Town Met is undoubtedly one of the most thrilling races in the land as it brings together the country's top horses who clash at weight-for-age terms.

The day at Kenilworth features top-class horses, a thrilling 12-race card, and lots of money to be won, all of which make tomorrow's race meeting at Kenilworth an enticing prospect.

TAB Win, Place, Swinger and Quinella pools on Races 4 to 11 at Kenilworth will be commingled into the Hong Kong Jockey Club tote, which operates the biggest tote pools in the world.

The commingled pools on each of the four bet types are set to average more than R6 million.

All other tote pools at the meeting will be hosted by TAB with the Pick 6 set to total more than R10 million courtesy of a R3-million carryover, and the Quartet on the Cape Town Met, with R500,000 kicking off the pool, is expected to generate a total pool of over R2 million.

In another first, bettors will be treated to three Jackpot, the first coming up on Races 1 to 4, the second on Races 5 to 8 and the third on Races 9 to 12, as well as two Bi-Pots, the first on Races 2 to 7 and the second on Races 7 to 12.

But the Met is where it all happens, and this year Justin Snaith will saddle four of the 11 runners, all of whom have winning chances.

Best of his quartet looks to be Jet Dark, an incredibly fluent win-

ner of the L'Ormarins Queen's Plate over 1600m two years in a row. But will 2000m find him out?

When the race was run on the old track (now the Winter Course) with the shorter run-in there was a belief the best miler always won the Met.

But that changed when the Summer Course came into play although Past Master, a top miler, did win the Met thanks to the infamous Cape Crawl.

However, jockey Gavin Lerena, who will be riding joint-favourite Kommetdieding, believes a pedestrian pace will not suit Jet Dark. "Jet Dark is quite an aggressive horse. I think he needs more of a steady pace," he commented.

Michelle Rix, who trains the four-year-old son of Elusive Fort with father Harold Crawford, revealed their charge had a bit of set-

back the Saturday morning of the Queen's Plate when he was found to be suffering from dermatitis.

The colt felt a lot of discomfort and although they considered withdrawing him from the race, decided it was their last chance to give him a warm-up run for the Met. "My feeling is that under the circumstances, his second place behind Jet Dark was like a win for us."

But both Rix and Lerena confirm that is all behind him and as the jockey added, "he's in a good space right now".

He is back over 2000m and that is probably his best distance.

During the KwaZulu-Natal winter season there was little to choose between Linebacker and Kommetdieding with the former getting the upper hand in the first two features but the latter coming

out trumps in the Durban July.

Vaughan Marshall's charge ran disappointingly when unplaced in the Queen's Plate but his trainer points out that a lot did not go right for him, especially the muddled pace, that left him flat footed at the top of the straight.

Linebacker will be reunited with jockey Grant van Niekerk who recorded three wins and two places in five races on the gelding.

Snaith is expecting a lot from three-year-old Double Superlative. The son of Twice Over did win the Grade 1 Cape Guineas from a wide draw.

"He's quite an unknown, which happens when you throw a three-year-old into a field with this class of older horses. You don't have any form lines to go by," said Snaith.

"I thought the three-year-olds

in the Queen's Plate ran very decent races and looking at the Guineas form line, Double Superlative looks the one they have to beat," he said.

But the question to be answered is just how good was that Guineas field, as some people have expressed the view that it was one of the weakest seen in a long time.

But, as jockey Anton Marcus is prepared to get down to 54kg to ride him, it speaks volumes about the respect he has for Double Superlative - and he has ridden three Met winners.

Filly Marina is the unknown quantity in the field. It is a massive jump in class for this daughter of Silvano but she looks very decent and will love this 2000m. She will be running on strongly in the straight and could run into the places.

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

Two horses who have thrived since moving up to the Highveld from the coast are Marchingontoegether and Majestic Mozart, and they look set to fight out the finish of Race 5 at Turffontein on Sunday, a Pinnacle Stakes over 2000m on the Standside track.

Majestic Mozart was trained in the Western Cape by Candice Bass-Robinson and although the Bass family still retain an interest in the six-year-old son of Dynasty, he was moved to Ashley Fortune's yard at the Vaal. One

of the strategies was presumably to give him a run in the Grade 1 Summer Cup where he put up an excellent challenge to run a 0.25-length second behind Flying Carpet.

But he has performed well on the Highveld and has recorded two wins among his four starts since his move. He has been carded to carry 60kg but with apprentice Kaidan Brewer aboard, it will take 4kg off his back and that should make him a massive runner.

Marchingontoegether was trained in KwaZulu-Natal but moved to trainer St John Gray

last September when he got involved in the ownership.

The six-year-old gelding has thrived under his tutelage and in six starts has won three times and placed on the other three occasions.

The most impressive of those victories came on 4 December when he literally sailed home by 11.25 lengths over the same course and distance as Sunday's race.

He followed that up with a very decent 3.85-length third behind Sparkling Water in a Pinnacle Stakes over 2400m at this course, giving the Mike de Kock-trained

filly 3.5kg. Considering she is now favourite to win the Grade 2 Cape Stayers over 2800m at Kenilworth tomorrow, that was a decent effort from the Pathfork gelding.

He also comes into this race as the best weighted runner, just 0.5kg ahead of Majestic Mozart.

Gavin Lerena has ridden him twice since Marchingontoegether arrived in Joburg, for a win and a one-length third behind Shangani and has been engaged to ride him again.

On the Summer Cup form horses like Golden Pheasant and Johnny Hero should be right on

their tails so it should be a thrilling contest.

Race 7 is the Listed Wolf Power 1600 and Mike de Kock-trained Al Muthana can finally pick up his first feature-race victory. He come off runs in the Grade 1 Summer Cup and the Grade 2 Onamission Mile and this time he takes a drop in class and looks the runner to beat.

Muzi Yeni has picked up the ride for the first time.

Chijmes ran a much-improved race last time and is 3kg better off with Al Muthana or a 2.75-length beating. So should finish a lot closer on this occasion.

Snaith to pull off G1 double in the Pick 6

FILLY: CAPTAIN'S RANSOM STANDS OUT AS BEST BET ON THE CARD

➔ **Rio Querari can go one better in Cape Flying Championship.**

Justin Snaith loves to win the races on important days and he could pull off a Grade 1 double at Kenilworth tomorrow with Captain's Ransom and Rio Querari.

In fact, both have claims to be considered bankers in the carryover Pick 6 which is expected to reach R10 million.

Snaith has a superb filly in Captain's Ransom and the four-year-old daughter of Captain Al can add a fourth Grade 1 race to her repertoire when she contests Race 8, the Schweppes Majorca Stakes over 1600m.

She won this race last year as a three-year-old to add to her victory in the Grade 1 Cape Fillies Guineas. She is seen at her best over 1600m, but her class pulled her through three weeks back when she captured the Grade 1 Majorca Stakes over 1800m.

For the first time she was pressed to the line but managed to keep her nose in front where it mattered.

The runners who finished second, fourth, fifth and sixth are all back for a second crack at lowering her colours in the Majorca Stakes but over 200m shorter they will need a miracle to do so.

Captain's Ransom has raced 11 times for nine wins and a place, her lone unplaced effort coming in the Grade 1 Garden Province Stakes at Greyville. She was drawn badly on a course where low number draws are vital and perhaps was rushed up in an effort to overcome her disadvantage which caused her to fade late.

But in the Western Cape, other



than a narrow defeat on debut, she remains unbeaten. What this filly has is the uncanny ability to quicken in a matter of strides and before her rivals can react, she has gone clear – and the race is over.

Jockey Richard Fourie will have to cope with No 10 draw which is not ideal, but is unlikely to hurt her at Kenilworth.

The main threat to her would have to be Chansonette, winner of this season's Cape Fillies Guineas. She went on to show her ability by finishing just a head behind Captain's Ransom in the Majorca Stakes.

Grant van Niekerk has built up a good rapport with this Andre Nel-trained filly and he does have the benefit of No 4 draw.

Princess Calla has had the misfortune of having to run against Captain's Ransom in all the fillies' features and has only seen her hindquarters on four occasions. She did have the edge in the Garden Province Stakes at Greyville but looks unlikely to get that same advantage in this race.

The Garden Province Stakes was won by Zarina who caused a 75-1 upset in doing so. Prior to that she was also a regular victim of Captain's Ransom and that order resumed in the Grade 3 Diana Stakes at Durbanville when Candice Bass-Robinson's runner ended up in fourth, 2.30 lengths behind Captain Ransom.

She's A Keeper had good form in KwaZulu-Natal but her best performances have been over further, and while she could place, she looks highly unlikely to upset the more fancied runners.

The Grade 1 Pongracz Cape Flying Championship over 1000m will see reigning Equus Champion Sprinter Rio Querari and rising star Real Gone Kid go head-to-head for the second time this season. And the result could well determine who will take Equus honours at the end of the season.

Rio Querari finished runner-up to Brett Crawford's Run Fox Run in this event a year ago and will obviously attempt to go one better in this year's renewal. He has had only

one comeback run this season, finishing a close 0.30-length second over 1100m at Kenilworth to Real Gone Kid when giving him 3kg. At level weights he should reverse the form.

It is obvious Snaith has prepped his runner specifically for this race.

Real Gone Kid, trained by Crawford, has won his last four starts, three this season, and is aiming to make it five in a row – a rare feat for any runner. Crawford's colt is by Snitzel out of Grade 1-winning Jet Master mare In The Fast Lane and a Grade 1 victory will secure his place in the stallion barn of owners Ridgemont Stud.

While Snaith has made winning Grade 1 events look easy this summer, Crawford, with a much smaller yard, has won at least one Grade 1 event every season for the last eight seasons. Victory here will see him maintain that record.

Among the rest of the field, the four most likely to challenge the two favourites are Hello Winter Hello, Captain Fontane, Bereave and Sound Of Warning.

Fourie's a jolly good fellow

If the bookmakers have it right jockey Richard Fourie is set for a field day at Fairview today when they race on the turf track.

He rides in all eight races, many for trainer Justin Snaith, and the first seven have been priced up as favourite while his runner in Race 8 is a strong second favourite.

He certainly should open the meeting in style where he rides Smith And Wesson for the Snaith stable. The United States colt ran second on debut and then faded late to finish sixth behind Street Outlaw, who is fancied to win the Listed Summer Juvenile Stakes at Kenilworth tomorrow.

Unless there is a hot-shot first-timer in the field, Smith And Wesson should prove far too good for the opposition.

Fourie also rides Follow The Star in Race 6, the Lakeside Handicap over 2400m.

This Glen Kotzen-trained mare has looked at her best this season and won nicely over the course and distance in October last year.

She beat rival in this race Miss Orange by 1.25 lengths and as there is a weight swing of 2.5kg, the chances are there it could be a different result this time, although Follow The Star may have won easier than the margin suggests.

There are another three feature races on the day and punters will be treated to some good racing.

Race 5, the Fairview Mile, sees Marmara Sea pull at the heart-strings one more time.

He has had a long, hard campaign and did find stable companion Carioca surprisingly a few lengths too good for him last time out.



A three-time winner from 11 starts, BOOMBA has not raced since finishing eighth when well-backed into favourite but jumping from a wide draw and looking unsuited. This week, first-up off a good trial for the in-form Fitzsimmons stable, BOOMBA has the advantage of a low draw under Oscar

Meanwhile, trainers Stephen Gray and Timothy Fitzsimmons are tied atop the trainers' table on six wins apiece, leading Shane Baertschiger by one win so far for the 2022 season. Manoel Nunes (7 wins) has a one-win lead over Oscar Chavez (6 wins) but with Nunes serving a one-meeting careless riding suspension this week, Chavez appears capable of assuming command in the jock-





➔ **Race a pointer to Grade 3 Jebel Ali Mile.**

Racing returns to Jebel Ali tomorrow for a competitive seven-race card, featuring a valuable 1600m conditions race that should provide some clues for the Jebel Ali Mile (Group 3) next month, the track's biggest race of the season.

Former UAE Oaks winner Down On Da Bayou, trained by Salem bin Ghadayer, was out of sorts last season, failing to fire in all three starts. Since returning from her summer break, she has progressed nicely with racing and impressed when winning a minor event, over the course and distance, under a positive front-running ride from Xavier Ziani last month.

Stepping up to Group 2 level and switched to turf in the Cape Verdi, she wasn't beaten far when fourth behind the French mare Pevensey Bay on her next outing, a creditable effort on only her second run on grass.

The daughter of Kentucky Derby winner Super Saver has a solid record at Jebel Ali and should win, especially drawn in stall one which is bonus for a confirmed front-runner.

Erasmio, officially the highest rated horse in the race, has his first start on dirt for Simon Crisford, eight days after trailing in nearly seven lengths behind Desert Fire in the Al Rashidiya (Group 2).

The French import, winner of four of his 11 races for Andre Fa-

bre, can boast a Group 3 victory in France last year, and if handling the underfoot conditions can go well dropping down significantly in class.

Crisford has booked James Doyle to ride Algiers in the 1950m rated conditions race, a contest that looks a lead-up race for the Jebel Ali Stakes (Listed) at the end of February.

Rated 107, he is the class act of the race but is unproven on dirt. Being by Shamardal, he's bred to cope with the conditions and demands obvious respect.

Tenbury Wells finished third behind the progressive Prevent, beaten less than four lengths by the winner who has never stopped improving this winter and will be aimed at the Jebel Ali Stakes. Trained by Salem bin Ghadayer, Tenbury Wells should reverse form with the runner-up (Castlebar) on these terms, and he gets the vote to open his UAE account at the fifth time of asking.

A small field has been declared for the valuable 1000m handicap, Race 4, but it's a competitive event with 2020 Jebel Ali Sprint (Listed) winner Alkaraama attempting to concede weight to his five rivals on his return to the scene of his biggest win.

Trained by Musabbeh Al Mheiri, he will appreciate the drop in grade having finished a one-paced third behind Switzerland in the Al Garhoud Stakes (Listed) on New Year's Day. Dane O'Neill, who had the choice of the three Shadwell owned horses, has chosen to ride Alkaraama ahead of Fanaar and the useful Thammin, winner of Jebel Ali Sprint three years ago.

Drummore, from the foot of the weights, is one to consider for trainer Helal Alalawi, who

has booked former champion Richard Mullen. He's attractively handicapped back on dirt and wasn't beaten far in a competitive sprint handicap on grass at Meydan, racing off a much higher mark.

Leading Spirit, trained by Bhu-

pat Seemar, comes here on the back of his best run of the season and is likely to go well over a track he has enjoyed success.

A maximum field of 16 go to post for the 1600m maiden, Race 2. It's a tricky contest and Doug Watson's US import King Of The

Nite gets a tentative vote. Formerly trained by Roberto Diodoro, he showed minor promise in three runs, most notably in two runs over 1200m at Churchill Downs, home of the Kentucky Derby. It looks significant Pat Dobbs has chosen to ride the son of Empire Maker, ahead of the 89-rated Anbar, the highest rated horse in the field.

La Baas, representing a yard that are in better form now having been slow to get going this season, is one to consider. Trained at Jebel Ali by Nicholas Bachalard, he produced an improved effort behind Discovery Island at Meydan, albeit was beaten eight lengths. The winner is a decent prospect and La Baas was far disgraced.

Line Of Sunshine, trained by Salem bin Ghadayer, has shown ability and comes here on the back of a respectable run behind Durandal on turf at Meydan. The winner looked above average that day and this test looks more suitable for Line Of Sunshine.

The unexposed Singapore import Zahau, trained by Bhupat Seemar, has progressed with racing since arriving in the Emirates and if seeing out the trip, he merits respect in first-time blinkers.

Fresu chases jockeys' title

ACTION: ITALIAN JOCKEY BAGS FIVE GOOD RIDES AT MEYDAN ON SUNDAY

➔ **Dahawi can get him off the mark in Race 6.**

Antonio Fresu, who enjoyed the biggest win of his career aboard the ill-fated Zenden in the Golden Shaheen at Meydan last March, is enjoying his best ever winter in the UAE and has emerged the chief threat to Tadhg O'Shea in the race to be champion jockey this season.

The Italian rider has five rides at the Dubai track on Sunday, four for his boss, Musabbeh Al Mheiri.

In the 1000m turf handicap, Race 6, Fresu rides the consistent and reliable Dahawi, winner of competitive handicap over the over the same course and distance earlier in the month. Trained by Al Mheiri, he has strong claims of following up and defying a career-high mark in a race that doesn't look the strongest.

Thunder Of Niagara and Alfolk, a late addition to the race when it was reopened on Monday, both contested a 16-runner 1000m handicap won by Jadwal seven days ago. The latter, trained by Doug Watson, ran third and it was his best run of the season to date.

It's an obvious concern Alfolk is 0-22 in the UAE and is winless since landing the Lebelo Sprint (Grade 3) for Mike de Kock at Turfontein in December 2017. However, this looks a good opportunity for the Shadwell owned gelding to finally get off the mark in the Emirates having tumbled in the weights since leaving South Africa.

Trained by Ahmad bin Harmash, Thunder Of Niagara was never competitive behind Jadwal, as he was badly drawn and couldn't land a blow. He should

be suited by the smaller field and can't be underestimated under Ray Dawson, the talented Irish rider.

Albion Square, who began his career with Jessica Harrington, makes a quick reappearance for Mike de Kock.

Last week he never threatened on his Meydan debut behind Silent Speech in the Dubai Trophy, weakening from halfway to finish a modest sixth. The Acclamation gelding faces a stiff task on his handicap debut taking on his elders and doesn't appeal.

The opening handicap, race 4, over 1400m on dirt sees Hyde Park try to follow up his hard-fought win at Jebel Ali. He showed a good attitude to deny Leading Sprit, finding plenty for pressure when staying on strongly up the punishing hill.

Trained by Salem bin Ghadayer, he has plum draw in stall one, a bonus given how horses drawn on the rails dominated the dirt races at Meydan on Sunday.

Tabarak, a winner over the course and distance, has been running well in defeat for Rashed

Bouresly, the latest when four length third behind Ranaan. He holds obvious claims under regular pilot Fernando Jara.

The Shadwell-owned Edaraat, winner at Sharjah last month, and Bhupat Seemar's Rayig complete the shortlist

The opening 1400m dirt maiden for three-year-old fillies, Race 2, is a weak contest and won't take much winning. The 88-rated Shadzadi, the choice of Tadhg O'Shea of the Zabeel Stables pair, sets the standard and ought to take plenty of beating.

She showed ability on her race-course debut at Jebel Ali prior to stepping up on that promise when third behind the exciting Shahama, over the course and distance.

A full field of 16 contest the 1200m maiden on turf, 35 minutes later. Riding arrangements suggest Sharp Spun is Doug Watson's main hope, with stable jockey Pat Dobbs electing to ride the 78-rated gelding who is having his first start on grass.

He comes on the back of two creditable efforts at Jebel Ali since joining Red Stables, the most recent when a staying-on fifth behind Yurman.

That performance deserved to be upgraded as he endured a wide trip and could never land a telling blow. Nicely drawn in stall No 4, he should put up a bold show.

Six days after failing to see off the late burst of Nibraas at Abu Dhabi in a 1400m maiden, Lake Causeway must enter calculations for the in-form Bhupat Seemar/Tadhg O'Shea partnership. If he has recovered from Sunday's exertions, he has sound claims of finally opening his account, especially jumping from an inside gate.

Racing concludes with a competitive 1600m handicap on dirt and looks wide-open, attracting plenty of in-form horses, many

representing the top local yards. The Pat Dobbs-ridden Sendeed, winner on his last visit to Meydan, leads Doug Watson's three-pronged assault, joined by Double Orb and US import Scabbard.

He's progressing nicely and holds sound claims of following up. Double Orb is a leading player if bouncing back to form he showed behind Gentile Bellini earlier in the campaign, while Scabbard is likely to need to race having off the track 148 days.

Top-weight Moqarrab, trained by Musabbeh Al Mheiri, caught the eye when winning a dirt handicap last month before struggling in a competitive handicap on turf. He has the advantage of being drawn in stall one and has to be considered.

Moqarrab's stable companion Atlantic Sky, the mount of Antonio Fresu, is potentially nicely treated off 78 on his handicap debut as he is very unexposed, having only fourth run of his life.

A winner at the course earlier in the campaign, he was fourth behind the useful Al Nefud, a creditable effort finishing less than seven lengths behind a horse that will be targeting major prizes later in the season.

Zero To Hundred, who impressed when winning his maiden over the course and distance, can't be overlooked. He's not the most reliable and is hard to catch right but if on a going day, he won't be far away.

Real World is the real deal

RECORD: FEATURE-RACE WINNER IN EUROPE LOOKS TOO STRONG IN G2 ZABEEL MILE

➔ **Dettori takes the ride for Saeed bin Suroor.**

Real World, trained by Saeed bin Suroor, is the star attraction when he makes his eagerly awaited comeback in the Zabeel Mile (Group 2) under Frankie Dettori at Meydan today.

By Dark Angel, Real World was undefeated when returning to Europe following his winter stint in the Emirates last year, racking up four wins, all on turf. On his final outing of the season, he landed the Prix Daniel Wildstein at Longchamp on Arc weekend, showing a likeable attitude in testing ground to narrowly deny The Revenant a third consecutive victory in the Group 2 event.

In-form Suroor, who saddled three winners at Meydan seven days ago, is seeking his first victory in the contest since Silvestre de Sousa steered Do It All to a shock victory nine years ago.

Real World, returning from a near four-month absence, is unlikely to lack for fitness as the five-year-old is reported to be targeting the Saudi Cup or the Neom Turf Cup at Riyadh next month.

Charlie Appleby has dominated recent renewals of the Zabeel Mile, winning the last three runnings and holds a strong hand, with One Ruler joined by recent surprise Meydan winner Path Of Thunder, the mount of William Buick. One Ruler, who needs to improve to reverse form with Path Of Thunder, is winless since October 2020, and doesn't appeal.

Path Of Thunder, ridden by

Richard Mullen, was eye-catching when defeating Moqtarreb and La Barrosa, storming clear off the hometurn to win easily. He will need to improve to upstage Real World stepping up to Group 2 level.

The UAE 1000 Guineas, the opening Classic of the season, has attracted a small field of six fillies, despite being reopened at Monday's five-day entry stage. Run over a mile on dirt, Race 4, the Listed contest looks a straight-forward task for the exciting Shahama, trained by Fawzi Naas.

The daughter of Munnings has done little wrong in winning her two starts, both over Meydan's main track. She's bred to be smart, being a half-sister to Lookin At Lucky, a multiple US Grade 1 winner and cost her connections \$425,000 (R6.5m) at Ocala Sale in April last year.

Nass has his team in good order and he has found Meydan a happy hunting ground this season, operating at impressive 24% strike rate.

In a weak renewal, Shahama is impossible to oppose and should maintain her unblemished record without being extended in the hands of Adrie de Vries.

The Graduate Stakes, a valuable 1600m event on dirt for horses purchased at any of the last three Racing in Dubai Sales, Race 2, has attracted nine runners. Eastern World, trained by Ahmad bin Harmash, made an encouraging start on his first start on dirt, finishing a creditable second to Tuz in the Dubai Creek Mile (Listed) at Meydan.

He needs to bounce back after failing to make an impact in the Al Maktoum Challenge (Round I) two weeks, trailing in nearly 10 lengths behind Golden Goal. He will appreciate the drop in class and is the highest rated horse in the nine-runner contest, so commands ob-

vious respect

Discovery Island, the choice of Tadhg O'Shea of Zabeel Stables two runners, won his maiden over 1200m on his dirt debut at Meydan last month, scoring with plenty in hand. He wasn't beaten far on his handicap debut two weeks later when finishing just over four lengths behind Quality Boone, leaving the impression he had more to offer.

The winner, trained by Antonio Cintra Pereira, gave the form a boost when splitting Rawy and Kiefer in the prep for the UAE 2000 Guineas.

Racing closes with the Dubai Sprint (Listed), a competitive race that has drawn an international cast, with runners from Australia, Bahrain and England facing five local sprinters in the 1200m event on turf.

Doug Watson, fresh from winning last week's big dirt sprint, the Dubawi Stakes, with Al Tariq, runs Motafaawit. He blossomed when dropped to sprinting last season and finished an unlucky fifth in the Al Quoz Sprint (Group 1), on the Dubai World Cup undercard, in March.

Owned and bred by Shadwell, Motafaawit made a solid comeback over the minimum distance two weeks ago following a 293-day break, keeping on nicely when finishing third behind Mutaraffa a fortnight ago.

He's weighted to reverse the form with the winner and this looks a good opportunity to record his first success in nearly 12 months.

Godolphin, typically, holds the aces in Race 3, the Al Khail Trophy. The Listed event, over a distance of 2810m on turf, was won by Dubai Future 12 months and the Dubawi gelding returns to defend his crown in good heart for Saeed bin Suroor, one of six runners for Godolphin.

He returned to his best when winning on opening night of the Dubai World Cup Carnival, easily defeating Star Safari and 14 others on his first appearance at Meydan since finishing a creditable fifth behind Mishriff in the Sheema Classic last season.

He makes plenty of appeal under Frankie Dettori.

Add-in boost for Soccer 10S

» English Championship matches form the core of tomorrow's principal Soccer 10 pool and log-leaders Fulham look a banker bet to win at home against Blackpool.

All three Soccer 10 pools tomorrow start with add-ins, including a R500,000 TAB add-in boost to the second Soccer 10 of the day (S10 V3), which comprises mostly English Championship games.

That sets the stage for a big payout because the pool is set to total over R2 million and Championship clashes produce upsets fairly regularly.

Two of the top promotion-chasing teams in the Championship have relatively easy assignments, but while Fulham are on a goal-scoring spree, Bournemouth having been looking a little tentative.

Earlier this month, Fulham became the first English team in 88 years to score six goals or more in three successive matches as they widened the gap between themselves and the chasing pack in the battle for promotion to the Premier League.

Their last outing at Stoke last Saturday was a bit more sedate.

They scored three, but won again to make it five victories in a row and a five-point lead. That lead should at least remain intact tomorrow, when they take on Blackpool at Craven Cottage.

Bournemouth are in third spot, having been toppled from the top of the table over the Festive Season. They are eight points adrift of Fulham and have won only twice in their last 10 league games.

They are, however, fancied to win away at bottom-placed Barnsley, who have relegation written all over them.

In between Fulham and Bournemouth in the standings are second-placed Blackburn Rovers, who have a tricky tie against Luton Town.

There could also be a surprise for West Bromwich Albion away at Millwall as they play a second game in four days.

The Baggies have had something of a goal-scoring crisis over the last month and have slipped down the standings, plus a trip to The Den is always dangerous.

Also this weekend the Africa Cup of Nations is at the quarter-final stage with the biggest possibility of an upset coming tomorrow when hosts Cameroon take on Gambia.

A few years ago the match would have been dismissed as a mere training exercise for the all-conquering Indomitable Lions, such was the gulf in quality and achievements between the two countries.

But Gambia have exploded onto the scene in their Cup of Nations debut and find themselves slaying giants.

They sensationally beat Tun-

sia in their last group game and then eliminated Guinea in the last-16 this week.

Cameroon's current genera-

tion are not a patch on some of their glory teams of the past, so there is every possibility of an upset.

Senegal will have the Crystal Palace midfielder Cheikh Kouyate back in midfield on Sunday in their Cup of Nations quarter-final against Equatorial Guinea in Yaounde. He missed the 2-0 win over the Cape Verde Islands on Tuesday because of suspension.

WOLVES SIGN STRIKER

Wolves have completed the permanent signing of South Korean striker Hwang Hee-Chan after a successful loan spell at the club. The 26-year-old moved to Molineux on a season-long contract from RB Leipzig. Since arriving in England he has scored four goals in 15 matches for Wolves as they continue their rise up the EPL table under Bruno Lage.

NEW BLOW FOR FATI

Barcelona's Ansu Fati faces another long spell on the sidelines following his latest injury. The young Barcelona striker has had a difficult time with injury over the last year, missing some nine months through a knee problem. He could now be out for a long time again because of a hamstring issue.

HULL SACK MANGER

Hull City have confirmed the sacking of manager Grant McCann following the takeover of the club by Turkish businessman Acun Ilicali. McCann was dismissed despite having just recorded back-to-back Championship wins over promotion-chasing Blackburn and Bournemouth.

BLOW FOR WBA

West Brom are seeking a short-term striker after losing Daryl Dike for two months with a hamstring injury. The 21-year-old American forward, signed from Major League Soccer side Orlando on New Year's Day, made his first Albion start on Saturday. But he went off 53 minutes into the 3-0 win over Peterborough and a scan on Monday showed the extent of the injury.
