NO SALE: KOMMETDIEDING TO STAY PUT AFTER MET SUCCESS

» Reynolds dedicates victory to the people of South Africa.

There must have been some wild parties on the Cape Flats on Saturday night after Kommetdieding won the Grade 1 World Sports Betting Cape Town Met over 2000m at Kenilworth.

Ridden superbly by Gavin Lerena, the Harold Crawford and Michelle Rix-trained son of Elusive Fort became the first horse since Igugu to pull off the Durban July and Cape Met double 10 years ago.

Kommetdieding found late support to go off favourite at 2-1 and did not disappoint, hitting the front early in the straight and then holding off the attention of first Linebacker (4-1) and then Jet Dark (9-2), to beat the Justin Snaith-trained dual Queen's Plate winner by 0.75 lengths. Linebacker was relegated to third, but only another 0.20 lengths back while three-year-old Double Superlative got fourth place, just 1.75 lengths off the winner.

The gallop was not that strong, and it was left to Rockin' Ringo to make the pace from Puerto Manzano and Cirillo. Lerena was able to use his No 1 draw to perfection as he had Kommetdieding in fourth place, just three lengths off the leader. Jet Dark and Linebacker were towards the rear with just Second Base behind them.

With a strong southeaster blowing, the jockeys brought their horses towards the outside of the course but Lerena stuck to the centre. Suddenly Linebacker made a strong forward move on the outside of the course and at one point headed Kommetdieding,

ing, while Jet Dark started his run up the inside. But despite losing his crop, Lerena got his mount back on track to easily hold off the challenges of the opposition.

Charismatic Ashwin Reynolds owns Kommetdieding and he was surrounded by supporters as he came to the winner's enclosure to lead in the horse.

"This win is for the people of South Africa," he exclaimed.

Lerena exuded praise for Kommetdieding. "He is an amazing horse with an amazing cruising speed.

"I must compliment Michelle and her team. He looked a picture today.

"And special mention needs to be made of Grant Behr. He's done such amazing work with this horse.

"I would like to thank him for all the hard work he's put in."

While in the parade ring Lerena spent a while getting some advice of one of the former stalwarts of the Cape racing scene, Karl Neisius.

The former top jockey gave Lerena an idea of the way the race was likely to pan out and where the field were likely to move coming into the straight.

Whatever he told Lerena it certainly must have helped as the race went according to plan.

It is always great for racing when a small stable pulls off a win of this magnitude and offers are likely to come in from all over the world.

However, they are likely to fall on deaf ears. "Kommetdieding is so much part of our stable I don't think he's going anywhere. We have had offers before and they were turned down."

She added that at this stage there were no plans for his future. "He will be off to the farm for a good rest and then we'll decide where we'll go with him."

Kommetdieding is still an entire and he could be the focus of a few local breeders.

Some good bets on the poly

As always, there are a number of very tricky races on the Greyville Polytrack today but there are some races where it could be worth taking a risk.

Nkalanzinzi and Tarantino look hard to beat in Races 2 and 7 respectively while interesting newcomer to KwaZulu-Natal, Valencia, could be hard to beat in Race 8 if he takes to the Polytrack.

Nkalanzinzi was expected to win her last race with ease when dropping to 1200m as she shows any amount of pace at the front over 1400m.

However, the speed was on from the go and she had to tuck in, didn't quicken and returned a beaten odds-on favourite. She was flying in her previous races and is a lot better than that.

Being back over 1400m in Race 2, a Maiden Plate for fillies, she should have nobody with pace enough to challenge her upfront. On top of that, she is going from an average merit rated race of 67 to a 56 and there looks to be very little competition this time. There is a first-timer in the hunt, River Club, who is bred for ground, so follow the betting moves on this one before going with Nkalanzinzi.

Tarantino runs in a Conditional Graduation over 1400m. He has not only raced with the best around but has gone close against them. In this race he retries the Polytrack and having been unlucky beaten when on the synthetic at Fairview, he showed that he could have a future on the surface.

Valencia has recently joined the Gavin van Zyl yard from Weiho Marwing's Highveld stable and has taken on a lot better than he will be meeting in this MR 67 Apprentice Handicap over 1400m.

He is drawn No 1, gets 4kg off his back and should come out on top.

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


